The work being carried out by my Ministry and the Government, through the vision of our Honourable Prime Minister, is substantial.

Since last year, we have launched and brought to completion many initiatives linked to Research and Innovation:

## For instance:

- We are continuously collaborating with international organisations to further enhance our knowledge and experience in Space Technology.
- We have organised a 3-day conference: Les Assises de la Recherche et de l'Innovation last year.
- Through this initiative we completed and made public the National Research and Innovation Roadmap.
- We have rewarded grassroots innovation through the National Innovation Challenge.
- We have organised Rodlnov in Rodrigues to inculcate the innovation culture in the Island.

By prioritising Innovation, Research, and Development, the Government not only stimulates economic growth but also addresses pressing challenges, enhances competitiveness, and improves the quality of life for our citizens.

Such initiatives ultimately pave the way for a brighter and more prosperous future for all of us.
