1.	Does MITCI have a preference towards a certain type of blockchain (for instance permissioned) and what are the key objectives the blockchain solution must attain?	Bidder to propose a cost-effective and scalable blockchain which is adaptable to the context of Mauritius and has the ability to process high volume of transaction. The block chain will need to achieve Self Sovereign Identity using a Digital wallet in the SuperApp and make use of selective disclosure including advanced cryptographic techniques of Zero Knowledge proof for sharing of information. The following documents is expected to be available in the Digital wallet 1. Mobile id 2. Health card 3. Driving License 4. Driving license counter part 5. Payslip 6. Birth Certificate 7. Marriage Certificate 8. Proof of Address 9. Pension contribution
2.	Is MITCI considering the SuperApp as the waypoint for a new domestic payment system (with tokenization and full integration in banking system)? Or it shall just allow to proceed payment to gov services using banking card?	No, The MITCI will be leveraging on the existing payment gateways (national payment switch (MAUCAS) and cards)
3.	Is the super app envisioned to include functionalities from private services, like banking, messaging?	Features such as banking and messaging could be envisioned.
