The Ministry of Information Technology, Communication and Innovation wishes to inform the public that it has received a significant number of queries from citizens attempting to access their Digital Driving Licence through the KOREK! mobile application and MauPass.

We understand that many users are currently experiencing difficulties because they are trying to locate a service that has not yet been deployed on KOREK!.

The Ministry wishes to clarify that while the Government has announced the introduction of the Digital Driving Licence, its implementation was subject to the necessary legislative amendments. In this regard, the Road Traffic (Amendment) Bill was successfully passed by the National Assembly yesterday, thereby providing the legal framework required for the deployment of the Digital Driving Licence.

Following the adoption of the legislation, the technical deployment process will now be initiated.

The Digital Driving Licence will be available on the KOREK! app once the relevant legislation comes into force.

Citizens are kindly requested not to attempt repeated access to the service at this stage, as it is not yet live.

The Ministry will communicate officially and extensively once the Digital Driving Licence becomes operational on KOREK! and ready for public use.
